

Seafresh plc granted Sustainability Award of Honour by the Stock Exchange of Thailand

The SET presented Seafresh plc with the high-profile award in recognition of our fourth year of high-ranking in Sustainability Excellence, as well as our continued efforts in sustainable business practice.

The award is only presented to companies recognised for the best sustainability performance in their market capitalisation category for at least three years running.

Seafresh plc is one of only eight companies ever recognised at this level. And this wasn't the only accolade presented at the ceremony, which took place in November in Bangkok, Thailand. The SET also awarded the company the Thailand Sustainability Investment (THSI) for the fifth consecutive year.

Along with this, Seafresh received an Excellent Corporate Governance score of 5 Stars for the third year in a row in the Corporate Governance Report (CGR) of Thai Listed Companies 2019. This report is jointly produced by the Thai Institute of Directors (IOD) and the SET.

Additionally, Seafresh received the CSR-DIW Continuous Award 2019 from the Department of Industrial Works for the fifth year, in acknowledgement of the company's progressive Corporate Social Responsibility programme.

These awards recognise our consistent high level of achievement in sustainable business practices in support of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). This shows our determination to improve the business in governance, transparency, economic, social, and environmental aspects, as well as stakeholder relations, and contributes to improving the sustainability of our business.
